Comments: Mr. Arcello's teaching and learning engages students as inquirers and thinkers, who are actively responsible for their own learning. He is skilled in verbal and non-verbal communication and provides for a safe and welcoming classroom environment. Student expectations and routines are clear and structured to maximize on student learning Students enjoy Mr. Arcello's class- he models both affective and effective teaching.

Comments: Mr. Arcello's teaching and learning differentiates instruction to meet students' learning needs and styles to access the curriculum within the classroom. He works closely school personnel to address student needs and ensure student success. He will continue to build lessons that are designed to provide openended tasks, discussions and activities which enable students to work at their own capacity and preferred learning style.

Comments: Mr. Arcello's assessment is based on collected data through observations, activities and set-tasks. He provides clear goals and expectations for student growth. His assessment data reflects achievement according to the learning objectives. He will continue to work on accurately reflecting student assessment/achievement on the report card.
